



Year 3/4 Autumn Term

English

This term we will be using the books:

- The Lancashire Giant - Ross Martin
- Tin Forest - Helen Ward
- Paddington - Michael Bond

The children will write folk tales, biographies, a narrative and an information leaflet.

Maths

This half term we will explore place value up to 1,000 (Year 3) or 10,000 (Year 4).

We will also be problem solving, reasoning and improving our fluency when working with the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division).

Science

In Science, we will be learning all about animals including humans, where we will be exploring the digestive system and teeth. During science lessons, we will be working scientifically whilst conducting experiments, including making our own digestive systems. We will also be investigating states of matter (solids, liquids and gasses).

History

This term, we will be learning about Fleetwood's early fishing industry and where the fishing boats went.

Geography

This term, we will be investigating why people live near volcanoes.
