



Year 1 Summer Term - Adventurous Me!

English

This term we will be reading the story 'The Magic Bed.' We will be using this story to write some of our own adventures. We will also be reading a selection of non-fiction texts around animals and plants creating writing links with science. We will also be looking at the poetry that tells a story. We will be learning to read and recite poems and use the structure to write our own.

Maths

Our maths work will see us working on place value for numbers within 100, addition and subtraction for numbers up to 50 and multiplication for 2,5,10 and division. Fractions of shapes and amounts.

Science

In science we will be learning about plants. We will be identifying and naming a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees. We will be identifying and describing the structure of plants. We will be continuing our ongoing topic of seasonal change. We will be continuing to observe the changes across the seasons with a focus on Spring and summer. We will be observing and describing the weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies.

Geography/History

We To identify the human and physical features of a non-European country Tucuaro in Mexico and compare it to our local area, Fleetwood. Our history will find us studying the lives of significant explorers from our past and looking at the impact that exploring has had on our world today.



Home Learning

Daily reading, Reading Eggs, Numbots and reading and writing of tricky words continue to be our focus at home.

Art/DT

For our artwork, we will be looking at painting and mixing colours. Exploring colour through printing. We will be studying the artist Clarice Cliff and using his ceramic plate designs as inspiration for our own pieces art. After half term in DT the children will be learning about wheels and axils. To understand how wheels move. To identify what stops wheels from turning. To design a moving vehicle. To build a moving vehicle.

Computing

Our computing work has us looking at movement control. We will start by using BeeBot robots and then do some work learning to control animations on screen.

RE

Through studying the religion, Islam, children will explore the question, how might beliefs about creation affect the way people treat the world? Then we will be looking at Hinduism and learning about 'What do Hindus believe about God?'

PE

Our PE sessions have us focused on rolling and bouncing a ball with accuracy as well as introductions to Thrigolf (Throwing golf) and athletics.

Music

We will be using Charanga to explore sound to create a story as well as having fun with improvisation.

PSHE

We will be learning about online bullying. Exploring, what is it like to grow up in our world? Then after half term we will be looking at hoax calling in relation to fire safety.
