



Year 3/4 Summer Term

English

This term we will be using the books:

- Mousehole Cat by Antonia Barber
- The Spider and the Fly by Mary Hewitt

We will produce a wide range of writing including non-chronological reports, diaries, letters, poems, thought bubbles and stories.

Maths

This half term we will be learning about: fractions and decimals. We will be exploring shape and the properties of different shapes. We will be learning about money, statistics as well as position and direction.

Year 4 will continue to practise their times tables daily in preparation for the Year 4 times tables test in June.

Science

In Science, we will be learning all about electricity. We will learn about the dangers and how to create a working circuit using these components: wire, cell, bulb, motor, switch, battery. We will solve problems. We will also learn about living things and their habitats.

History and Geography

This term we will be learning about the 'Ancient Maya' civilisation where we will explore how their achievements impacted their society and beyond. We will also explore where our food comes from in geography including the impact it has on our environment.

PSHE

We will explore the topics of working in our world, looking after our world, fire safety, texting while driving and transition to our next year.
