

# Larkholme Primary School

## Key Stage 2 Results - July 2016

### Attainment

This attainment table displays the percentage of our school pupils who achieved the expected standard at the end of Year 6 and also shows the figures achieved nationally.

The scaled score is a new measure. A pupil's raw score is converted into a scaled score to enable accurate comparisons to be drawn over time. A scaled score of 100 represents the expected standard on the test. If a pupil's scaled score is 110 or more they have achieved at the greater depth standard. As there is no scaled score system for writing (it is teacher assessed - there is no test) children working above the expected standard attain at the greater depth standard.

### Progress Scores

**Reading score:** -3.1

This indicates that pupils on average have not done as well at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally.

**Writing score:** 1.2

This indicates that pupils on average have done better at KS2 than those with similar prior attainment nationally.

**Mathematics score: 0.1**

This indicates that pupils on average have done better at KS2 than those pupils with similar prior attainment nationally.
