

## Year 1 & 2 Knowledge Organiser – Human Body & Senses

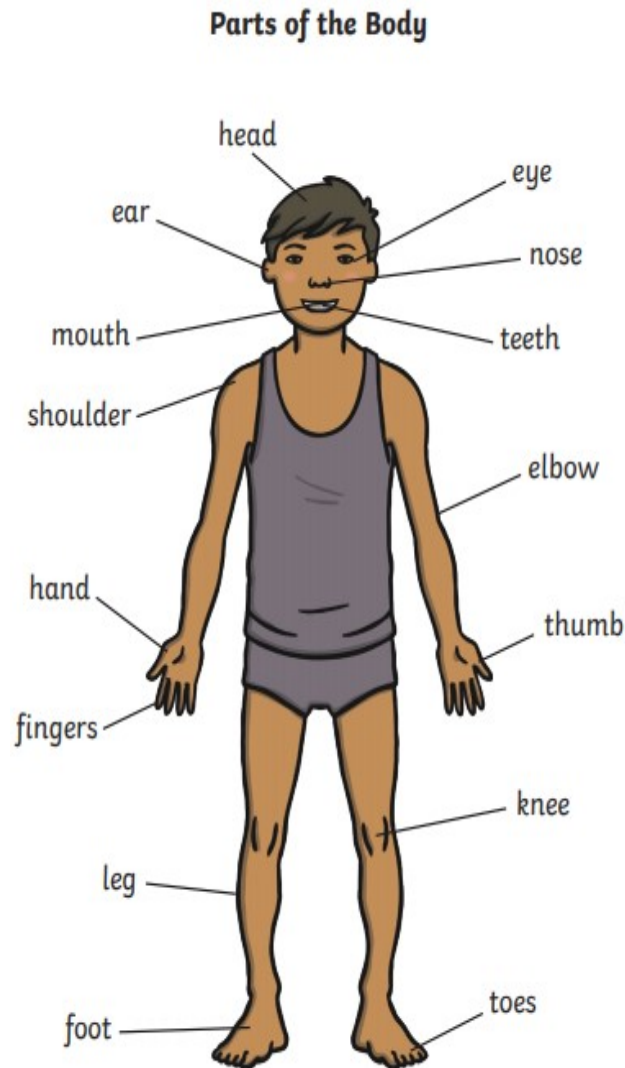
### What should I already know?

### Key vocabulary

eyes	These help us see
ears	These help us hear
mouth	We use our mouth to eat and talk
nose	Helps us smell
elbows	These help our arms bend
knee	This helps our leg bend
shoulders	These help our arms to lift up
eyebrows	These protect our eyes
neck	Connects the head to the rest of the body
feet	They help us stay balanced and upright
