EYFS Summer Term 1 - Ticket to Ride

Literacy

This half term we will cover the books:

How to catch a star

Look Up!

The Man on the Moon

We will use Talk for Writing to add actions, sequence the story and retell it in our own words. We will then use these texts to support us in reading words and sentences as well as seamenting to write our own sentences.

Understanding the World

In Science we will be learning all about keeping our bodies healthy. We will learn the importance of staying clean and how germs can make us poorly. We will learn to understand the role of a dentist and why exercise is important.

In History and Geography we will be learning how to read simple maps and exploring the world around us. We will be recognising similarities and differences between life in this country and other

Maths

This half term we will be building on our previous knowledge of addition by applying it to learn our numbers bonds to 5 and 10 as well as adding our doubles together.

We will then move on to sharing quantities out equally and recognising which numbers we can share and which we can't share. We will then learn some new vocabulary of odd and even numbers.

Home Learning

We will be sending a piece of learning to be completed at home based on each of our key texts from Literacy.

How to catch a star - Can you make your own story map to retell the story?

Look Up! - Can you draw a picture of things that you would take in your suitcase with you if you were going to space?

The Man on the Moon - Can you make your own rocket using junk modelling resources that you have found around your house?

Computing

In Computing we will be exploring how we can stay safe online. We will also explore sensible amounts of screen time use.

Phonics

This half term we are beginning to learn the final Phase 3 graphemes and we will also be learning our Phase 4 tricky words.

Whilst learning these we will continue to practice our blending and segmenting skills as well as working on our letter formation in words and our sentence reading and writing.

Expressive Arts and Design

In Art, to develop our painting skills we will be mixing colours and exploring the thickness or paint by painting our own sky pictures. These may be night sky pictures or sunset pictures. We will also be working on 3D by using paper mache to make our own planets.

In DT, we will be exploring with different structures and ways of connecting different materials together by making our own rockets. We will also be looking at different mechanisms and programming them. We will do this by using a beebot to follow a simple map.

RE/PSED

In PSED we will be learning about the different and appropriate ways of asking for help or support from our peers. We will also be learning how to resolve conflict within a group.

In RE we will be learning about places that are special to different people and why. We will be learning about churches, mosques and mandir.

Music

We will be learning to sing along to nursery rhymes and action songs. We will also be exploring music from around the world and how we respond to the rhythm.

PE

This half term in our PE lessons we will be continuing to develop and improve our fundamental movement skills.

We will start by working on exploring and developing the different ways in which we can travel around a space. We will also be recapping on our previously learnt knowledge of throwing a ball and also developing our strength to pull ourselves up onto the equipment.
